Assistant Principal's Report

A reminder to parents that if your child is on short term medication that needs to be administered at school during the day (for example medicine for colds, antibiotics etc) we need a letter explaining the dosage, the time it is to be taken, before or after food and permission for it to be given. This medication needs to be handed into the office for safe keeping during the day. Your child's class teacher needs to know about the medication as well however they do not administer it. It is done through the office.

It is also time to remind parents to continue their weekly head lice checks at home. This is a routine that we would encourage all parents to maintain and alert us if you find head lice as it helps us alert the parent community.

With the constant change in weather students need to wear their jumpers more however the warmer afternoons mean they take them off. To help with the volume of lost property and students finding their jumpers, hats etc it is always good to have clothing clearly marked with their names so if they are lost the owner is easily located. For our Year 3 – 6 students who will be taking part in the swimming program for the next two weeks this will be very important.
